On Thursday, July 13, our Men's Club once again enjoyed a great tournament, put on by our Tournament Chair Kevin Andel. This was our Solo-Plus Team Scramble. We had a great turnout and everyone I spoke with enjoyed the format. We have two tournaments planned in August. Our first one is the "Four Clubs is All You Get" format. This tournament will be held Thursday August 17 and has been a club favorite for the past few years. Please mark your calendars and plan to attend. Sign-ups will be through Golf Genius and there will be a hot dog lunch following the play. You are only allowed four clubs in your bag (you pick). This will be an individual low net by flight, with random pairings. There is a \$20 entry fee paid at time of play with closest to the pin on holes #10 & #17. We plan to pay based on flights probably four depending on how many sign up. As a reminder, please make sure that when you sign up on golf genius you remember to mark your calendars and don't forget to show up for play. We make many decisions including paying for lunches as well as pairings based on those sign ups. It causes a great deal of shuffling when someone signs up and does not show up. Our second tournament in August is the Men's Club Mixed Scramble and will be held Sunday afternoon the 27th. This tournament is open to all Men's Club members. You can sign up as a foursome (two men & two women) or sign up as a twosome (one man & one woman). The format is a four-person team scramble, with three drives per player required. The sign ups for this tournament will be through the signup sheet on the bulletin board or through the pro Men's Club, cont'd. shop. This event is more about socialization, fun, food...and not as much the competition. The entry fee will include dinner on the patio following the play, as well as sweeps. The check-in time is 12:30 pm with a shotgun start at 1:00pm. At this writing we are still working on the price with Sequoia Woods management but will keep you posted.
